DECLARATION OF THE SECOND NATIONAL CONFERENCE

09/08/2007

On 11/11/2006, the first ever national conference for Arab-American engineers, architects, and computer professionals was hosted by the AAAEA in Chicago, Illinois. The meeting was attended by representatives from 7 states and produced a 5-year strategic plan to establish a national engineering association in the United States.

The Second National Conference was held in Dearborn, Michigan on 9/01/2007 under the theme of "Going National Together" and attended by representatives from MI, IN, IL, WI, TX, FL, NY, NJ, CT, and CA. Representatives from LA and WA were not able to attend. The meeting discussed the timetable, components and infrastructure for a national organization. Among the subjects discussed were structure, bylaws, e-newsletter, mission, duties, legal, name, and selecting a steering committee.
